



JUNE 2018 BOARD REPORT

- Custodians are upgrading a/c units on most of the 2nd & 3rd floor that were acquired from South School last summer.
- We are in the process of moving some special education classrooms to accommodate the lack of the WOVSED Classroom that formerly “housed” emotional and communication disorder students. The changes include location and physical modification to a couple areas.
- The football field grass is not in very good shape in several large areas. Michael Brewer has been in contact with those with our service contract to make sure whatever needs to be done is not decided too late.
- It is time to resurface and paint the all-weather track. There have been discussions at MCHS Sports Booster Meetings about funding and timetables but they have not committed any amount of money at this time. Tyler Buss has contacted companies to give us estimates and we were told that they could be here in September. We think the total cost to fill, resurface, and paint would be in the \$17,500 - \$19,000 range, based on an old estimate. The Board of Education will need to have a discussion on how this will be paid for.
- MCHS summer school has been a success to this point. Tracie Guard has kept me updated and some have already finished and the others are on track to attain the needed credit.
