During the winter weather, the grade school had internal electrical issues that caused breakers to blow. Most of the issues have been repaired; however, the surge caused the compressor for the kitchen's walk in cooler to fail. The compressor is damaged and will need either substantial repair or replaced.

There is still a lot of confusion with the 2019-20 school calendar. I am still awaiting clarification from Springfield. Until then, I will not develop a District calendar.
